## Attention Auburn Seniors

**The Auburn Township Trustees are joining forces with the Geauga County Department on Aging for the 2019 Auburn Senior Trash Pick-Up Days, May 30 and 31.**

If you are a senior citizen who lives in Auburn Township, and have unwanted items that need to be picked up at your home during the trash pick-up days, sign up now.

In order to be placed on the clean-up list, you must first be registered with the Geauga County Department on Aging by May 23, be 60 years of age or older and live in Auburn township. Contact information is below. The Department on Aging and the Auburn Road Crew will pick up refuse from registered seniors who need assistance.

**The Department on Aging can no Longer go into seniors homes to pick up unwanted items. The Auburn Township Road Crew and the Department on Aging will pick up refuse from Auburn senior's Garages, out buildings and Drives and take it to the township dumpster. Please have items outside evening before the pickup. Do not place items curbside.**

**Please note the following guidelines:**

**To prevent possible bed bug transference (or other pest), all mattresses, couches and upholstered furniture MUST be wrapped in plastic and taped securely or they will not be taken.** No liquids, paint, or other hazardous materials, construction debris, rocks, yard waste, or household garbage will be accepted. We will accept up to 6 tires and appliances and other unwanted items. No propane tanks will be accepted.

**Please, only 10 household items per home**, and the items must be from that senior's household only. All materials should be consolidated in strong boxes and items should be kept dry (tarp) if possible.
