**RESOLUTION OF CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY FOR  
THE IMPROVEMENT OF TAYLOR MAY ROAD (TR 186), SECTION E**  
Auburn Township, Geauga County, Ohio

**WHEREAS**, the Auburn Township Board of Trustees (Board) has determined that the public convenience and welfare require the improvement of Taylor May Road (TR 186), Section E, from Munn Road (CH 32) to Auburn Road (CH 4), in Auburn Township, and to authorize the Geauga County Engineer to prepare engineering plans in accordance with Section 5573.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by a unanimous vote of the Board that the public convenience and welfare requires these improvements by repairing the existing pavement and embankments, replacing culverts, improving drainage structures, subgrade stabilization, asphalt resurfacing, stabilizing the shoulders, and related improvements, as necessary.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Geauga County Engineer is hereby directed to make such surveys, plans, profiles, cross sections, estimates and specifications as required for the improvement and to transmit copies of the same to this Board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the costs and expenses of said improvement shall be apportioned as follows:

The right of way costs, if any and the construction costs for the project shall be paid from local funding sources and state grants and/or loan funds should they be available for this project. The engineering will be provided by the Geauga County Engineer at no cost to the Township.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Fiscal Officer of the Board is hereby instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Geauga County Engineer.
