

Auburn Township Road Dept. Report

April 2018

- The month of April had several light snow events with only one requiring plowing and or salting. Twenty six tons of material were used which brings the new yearly average usage to 1759 tons. There currently is ~300 tons of road salt in our dome with 475 tons outstanding to be purchased on the 2017 contract.
- Cold patching was done several times on various roads with 8 tons of material used.
- There was one high wind event and one high water event. Trees came down on Stafford Rd. and Shaw Rd. and water did crest and run over Bartholomew Rd.
- Recent signage installed on Eastwood Dr. was again removed but not taken. The sign and posts were reinstalled.
- The 33% reduced load limit was released by the Geauga County Commissioners and signs removed on April 30th.
- Preparations for capital improvement projects began with the saw cutting of pavement for the replacement of cross culvert pipes.
- There was one urn burial at Shadyside Cemetery.
