

Auburn Twp Road Dept Report

November 2017

- November 5th storms knocked out power and downed trees around the township. The road department worked from 6:30pm Sunday until 1:00am Monday to clear and open roadways where live wires were not involved. Storm cleanup continued until Wednesday afternoon November 8th.
- Additional brush clearing was done on Greatwood Ln. and Quinn Rd. along with roadside mowing.
- Trees along the 2018 Taylor May Rd Resurfacing Project were marked as well as trees in the Mapleshade Cemetery for removal with quotes received and reviewed by the board of trustees.
- There were two snow events that required 45 tons of deicing material and two rounds of plowing and or salting. This brings November's average road salt use to 77 tons. We currently have ~ 725 tons
- Repairs were done on the old town hall's drainage system which corrected occasional backups.
- Signs were replaced or repaired due to vandalism, these were Ladue Trail and Spiceberry Lane street name signs and one 25mph speed limit sign.
- One grave was topped at Shadyside Cemetery and one large headstone moved back into position with minor storm damaged tree limbs cleared from the drive.
- Erosion control was done on Meadow Ln. with 20 tons of #1 gravel used to stabilize the ditch.
- All Township building and road department equipment fire extinguishers were inspected and serviced.
