The Public Hearing for the proposed Zoning Amendment AUB2017-01 Medical Marijuana was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Michael S. Troyan. All Trustees were present.



**Chairman Michael S. Troyan** read the following Exhibit 1, 3.08 Medical Marijuana:

**3.08 MEDICAL MARIJUANA PROHIBITION** (date): In all zoning districts medical marijuana cultivators, processors, or retail dispensaries shall be prohibited in accordance with O.R.C. Section 519.12

Carl Schneider asked a question.

Michael S. Troyan clarified that all facilities, including dispensaries, are prohibited.

Patrick J. Cavanagh explained that Federal Laws still prohibit marijuana.

Mr. Schneider asked what the majority of other townships in Geauga County were doing.

Michael S. Troyan explained most townships are prohibiting medical marijuana businesses.

Mr. Ryan asked a question about it being a Zoning Amendment with the availability to ask for a variance.




Mr. Troyan said, "Yes, that's correct."


There was some discussion about licensing for marijuana facilities.
