Held \_\_The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman John A. Eberly. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Ford.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on January 20, 2020. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

## **REPORTS:**

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, presented his zoning report for January reflecting 5 applications received and 5 permits issued. He presented his recommended zoning application fees for 2020. The Trustees reviewed his recommendations.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by John A. Eberly to adopt the 2020 Zoning Application Fee Schedule as revised and presented. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

Mr. Kitko presented that there was a problem with one of the phones in the zoning office. The Trustees spoke to looking into a phone system. They will research other townships to see what phone system they are using.

Emerick Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent, gave the following report for January:

- January saw 12 weather events that required 20 rounds of plowing and or salting. The
  total usage of deicing materials was 481 tons which brings the month's average to 633
  tons. We are currently running about 80 tons less than average for the first half of winter
  service season. There is about 826 tons of road salt in our dome.
- There was one high wind event that did bring down several trees on January 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Patching of potholes was performed on two different occasions with approximately 1 ton of material used.
- We did have two speed limit signs taken out by cars running off the roadway.
- The county engineers office has been monitoring and enforcing the cleaning of mud and debris left on Shaw Rd. due to the oil wells that are being installed. The logging that is being done on an adjacent neighbor's property does not fall under highway use and the township has been watching this job site.
- We have had dialogue with the county engineer's office concerning our 2020 capital improvement projects and everything is moving forward.

Emerick spoke to the Resolutions proposed by the Geauga County Engineer for Convenience and Necessity and a Memorandum of Understanding to provide pavement markings on township roads. He recommended the MOU for striping. Trustee Cavanagh read the MOI.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michaels S. Troyan to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Auburn Township Board of Trustees and the Geauga County Engineer for the application of pavement markings to various roads in Auburn Township to which the estimated cost is \$10,000.00 but the final cost will be based upon bid unit prices and actual quantities installed. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

Discussion as to sharing costs with Mantua ensued. Emerick will keep Mantua informed.

Michael S. Troyan spoke to the 2020 NOPEC Energized Community Grant awarded to Auburn in the amount of \$20,200.00. He spoke to the Auburn Fire Station conversion to LED lighting project which was started last year. An estimate to convert the entire facility to LED was presented from Triple A. Electric, Inc. for \$26,926.00. In 2019 the project was started utilizing \$11,646.00 of the 2019 NOPEC Energized Community Grant. Mr. Troyan would like to use a portion of this year's NOPEC grant to finish the fire station project.

Patrick J. Cavanagh spoke to the Nature Works grant and the agreement made with ODNR. He suggested we may want to consider having CRWP administer the grant.

**John A. Eberly** spoke to what type of pavilion we might want. He suggested building one similar to the South Russell pavilion to which he has obtained plans. He spoke of adding gutters and making a few changes.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

The Trustees discussed the NOPEC Community Grant in the amount of \$1,500.00.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to divide the NOPEC Community Grant evenly and recommended \$375.00 be awarded to the following civic groups in Auburn Township: Boy Scouts 101, Cub Scouts, Giggles & Stitches 4H, and the Kenston Girl Scout Troops. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

The Trustees discussed joining Ohio Township Association CLOUT.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by John A. Eberly to adopt Resolution 2020-06 authorizing Auburn Township to be a member of Ohio Township Association CLOUT and to pay the annual CLOUT membership dues. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

The Trustees discussed the seasonal position at the Road Department.

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE AUBURN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE GEAUGA COUNTY ENGINEER FOR THE APPLICATION OF PAVEMENT MARKINGS TO VARIOUS TOWNSHIP ROADS, YEAR 2020

Auburn Township, Geauga County, Ohio

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described;

WHEREAS, approximately 4.06 miles of Auburn Township maintained roads are in need of improvement by application of pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, the Geauga County Engineer's Office improves a portion of County-maintained highways by the application of pavement markings through its annual application of pavement marking project, herein hereinafter called the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, the public interest is best served through the cooperation of the Geauga County Engineer and the Auburn Township Board of Trustees to improve the various Township maintained roadways.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Auburn Township Board of Trustees, Geauga County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** The public interest demands the improvement and maintenance of the roads situated in Auburn Township.

**SECTION II.** The Geauga County Engineer has offered to be the lead agent to improve the various roads maintained by Auburn Township.

**SECTION III.** The Auburn Township Board of Trustees wish to participate and the funds for the reimbursement shall come from funds available to Auburn Township to improve and repair roads and related items.

SECTION IV. The Auburn Township Board of Trustees agrees to fund a portion of the total cost of the improvements performed in conjunction with the Project. The division of funds will be based upon the centerline straight line mileage of work performed. The County Engineer's estimate for the Township portion is \$10,000.00, but final cost will be based upon bid unit prices and actual quantities installed. The funds shall be reimbursed to the Geauga County Engineer within thirty (30) days of the completion and acceptance of the work, but before payment to the Contractor by the Geauga County Engineer.

**SECTION V.** The Geauga County Engineer is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees to enter into contracts and agreements with the lowest and most qualified bidder to complete the construction of the improvement.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Auburn Township Fiscal Officer is hereby instructed to transmit both original signed copies of this resolution to the Geauga County Engineer for acceptance. Upon acceptance by the County Engineer, one original copy will be returned to the Township.

# RESOLUTION OF CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS OF VARIOUS ROADS Auburn Township, Geauga County, Ohio

WHEREAS, the Auburn Township Board of Trustees (Board) has determined that the public convenience and welfare require the improvement of Snow Road (TR 145) from Stafford Road to the Newbury Township Line, Bartholomew Road (TR 195) from Auburn Road (CH 4) to Ravenna Road (SR 44), Wing Road (TR 198) from Washington Street (CH 606) to Stafford Road, Brookfield Drive (TR 740), Cinnabar Trail (TR 878), Chanticleer Court (TR 981), Chateau Trail (TR 982), Champlain Trail (TR 983), Alex Way (TR 1020), and Stella Lane (TR 1021), and to authorize the Geauga County Engineer to prepare engineering plans in accordance with Section 5573.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by a unanimous vote of the Board that the public convenience and welfare requires the improvement by repairing the existing pavement and embankments, replacing culverts, improving drainage structures, asphalt resurfacing, application of chip seal, stabilizing the shoulders, and related improvements, as necessary.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Geauga County Engineer is hereby directed to make such surveys, plans, profiles, cross sections, estimates and specifications as are required for the improvement and to transmit copies of the same to this board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the costs and expenses of said improvement shall be apportioned as follows:

The right of way costs, if any and the construction costs for the project shall be paid from local funding sources and state grants and/or loan funds should they be available for this project. The engineering will be provided by the Geauga County Engineer at no cost to the Township.
