The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman John A. Eberly. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Patrick J. Cavanagh.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on April 20, 2020. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

ESSENTIAL BUSINESS:

The Trustees discussed Franchise fees received.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by John A. Eberly to deposit franchise fees received from SuddenLink in the amount of \$2,855.09 into the Land Acquisition and Improvement Fund. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; Eberly, yes. The motion passed.

The Trustees discussed 4th of July and Memorial Day township events.

Fredrick May, Fiscal Officer, presented an Appropriations Report, Fund Status Report, Revenue Report and a Payment Report listing warrants 5773 through 5809 totaling \$32,375.65.

John A. Eberly read the following April road report submitted by Emerick Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent:

- The final deliveries of road salt for the 2019 / 2020 contract were received. We have approximately 1800 tons of deicing material in our dome and are supplied for the beginning of next winter. Here is the current standing for the 2020 / 2021 ODOT Salt Contract from their website, "ODOT continues to monitor the current COVID-19 situation. At this time, we have not made any decision on the POST or OPEN date of the next salt contract. Local Municipalities have inquired about the current deadlines to submit your salt requests and resolutions. A decision on whether to extend this date has not been determined at this time. We understand that it may not be possible for Local Municipalities to meet and obtain a signed resolution by the April 24th deadline. ODOT will work those Local Municipalities that are unable to obtain a signed resolution by the deadline. However, we recommend that you submit the requested quantity through the electronic application as soon as you have determined this amount. This will allow us to gather your information and include it with the contract. A signed copy of the resolution should be submitted upon collection of the required signatures. We recommend that you monitor this site weekly for any updates or possible extensions".
- The beginning preparations for our 2020 Capital Improvement Projects started with ditching and brush removal on Bartholomew Rd. Projected start date is July 6th for the resurfacing although some excavation involved with the replacement of the 42" cross culvert pipe on Brookfield Rd. may begin in mid-June.
- Cold patching was done on various roads as well as erosion control due to heavy rains.
- There a couple downed trees removed as the result of winds associated with storms.
- An additional sinkhole opened up on Lucky Bell Ln. that had to be stabilized with #1 gravel. This is the sixth significant sinkhole in the Lorien Woods subdivision.
- There were no interments for the month in the cemeteries.
