GUESTS:

Don Rice, Metzenbaum Executive Director, gave an update of the Center and noted they provide service to county residents 3 months to 93 years old. In 2021 they provided service to 1004 people. He reminded the Board that the majority of their funding comes from levies.

REPORTS:

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, submitted a zoning report reflecting 13 applications processed in the month of March resulting in 12 permits issued.

Patrick J. Cavanagh, gave the following report for March which was submitted by Emerick Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent:

- The month saw seven weather events that required nine rounds of plowing and or salting. Salt usage for the month totaled 241 tons. That brings the new monthly average to 152 tons and as of today 1803 tons total for the season. The adjusted yearly average is 1747 tons. Currently we have ~1400 tons of material in our dome with an anticipated order of 500 tons to not only fill the dome but satisfy our contracted committed amount.
- Patching of roads with cold mix material continued along with removal of a few downed trees due to high winds.
- The Stafford Rd. Reconstruction Project resumed and will continue on until completion. Weekly update meetings are scheduled with the contractor and the Geauga County Engineers Office.
- Bid openings were held for the 2022 capital improvement projects and award recommendations soon to follow from the engineer's office.

Our focus is to provide services while building a caring community where individuals are integrated, accepted, and achieving. These services begin at birth and continue through school and adulthood, till their end of life.

404 people used FHBS to care for thier loved one

Over 58 area businesses employ our individuals

Early Intervention

 Early Intervention (EI) provides coordinated services to parents of eligible children ages 0-3 years with developmental delays or disabilities. A total of 252 children received services in 2021.

Employment First

 Employment services are designed to help adults find what fits best for them and their goals. In 2021, the program worked with a total of 565 individuals, of which 165 are employed in minimum wage or above.

Transportation

 GCBDD coordinated with 22 companies in 2021 to ensure the transportation services of roughly 400 individuals to and from their day programs or jobs in the community.

Intermediate Care Facilities

 In partnership with Jewish Family Services Association, the Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) currently provides residential care at the Metzenbaum Center for 15 individuals ranging in ages from 30 to 74.

Community & Residential Services

- A total of 1,004 individuals received services in 2021 through GCBDD.
- Over 306 individuals received residential supports in our community in a variety of settings.
- There were 340 school aged children eligible for services in 2021, of which 45 were Amish students.

Metzenbaum Foundation

- GCBDD partners with the Metzenbaum Foundation to provide individuals with grant opportunities throughout the year for community outreach activities and events, recreational services, and resources.
- Family Home Based Supports (FHBS) program supported 253 children and 151 adults and their families to help care for their child or relative in their home.
- Summer Supports Funds program sponsored 87 school aged children to participate in summer camps, activities, and funds for respite.
