The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Eugene T. McCune Jr. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chief Phillips.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on May 16, 2022. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on June 6, 2022. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

REPORTS:

Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a May YTD statistics report comparing 346 calls in 2022 to 320 calls in 2021. The percentage of multiple calls was 19.94% in 2022 versus 21.87% in 2021.

Chief Phillips reported the department sold their old rescue squad on GovDeals today for \$16,450. He reminded everyone of the 4th of July Parade event will commence from the Meadows Subdivision at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, July 4th. A group of Auburn residents including Matt England and Joe Plavcan are in charge of the event and the Cub Scouts will be selling dogs and beverages. AVFD will handle traffic control.

Michael S. Troyan had no report.

Patrick J. Cavanagh reported the 2022 Crack Seal Project is out for Bid. The BID deadline is 4:00pm July 5th and the opening is at the Board of Trustees meeting the same day.

He noted as we close out the Stafford Road Project, Eclipse Co. may go to the dispute resolution committee due to the increased cost of asphalt. They have asked Auburn to approve a \$100,000 cost increase. We are looking into using ODOT price index at the time the asphalt is put down to gage the increase. Dispute resolution is an accepted practice. The Board of Trustees does not have to go along with the committee's recommendation; it is not in the ORC.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. raised issue that it was the contractor's fault that they didn't complete the project and costs went up. It was raised that we were under the impression that Eclipse Co. would honor the final contract price.

Trustee Troyan raised the point that utility poles were not moved when they were scheduled to be and it may have impeded work.

Trustees discussed other issues out of Eclipse's control. We are waiting for a number from the County Resolution Committee.

2022 Chip Seal of Franks and Wing Roads is starting soon by Ronyak Paving.

Trustee McCune Jr. asked if anyone attended the Chagrin Valley Jaycees. No one did.

Fredrick May, Fiscal Officer, presented an Appropriations Report, Fund Status Report, Revenue Report and a Payment Report listing warrants 7165 through 7189 for a total of \$18,000.06 and a Payment Report listing warrants 7121 through 7163 for a total of \$437,106.85. He submitted Resolution 2022-18 and Resolution 2022-19.

Mr. May reported receiving a tax invoice on Auburn Community Park which has tax exempt status. Fred and Nancy will check into the issue with the Auditor's Office.

ARPA reporting is up to date. The AVFD is still working on requests for ARPA funding. We have received three applications for the Assistant to Fiscal Officer job.

Patrick J. Cavanagh commented we need to have 1 levy run for a shorter period. The Board discussed which second levy they should place on the November's ballot.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to pass Resolution 2022-21 declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation and renew the 2 mill levy for 5 years originally passed in 2014. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.

The Board of Trustees each signed a "no conflict of interest" form for Chagrin River Watershed Partners.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to add Juneteenth to the official holiday roster giving employees a floating holiday that can be taken at any time effective 2022. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes, McCune, yes. The motion passed.

Chairman McCune read the upcoming event dates off the agenda.

The Trustees discussed entering the Road Department truck into the 4th of July parade this year.
