The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Patrick J. Cavanagh. Trustees Troyan and McCune Jr. were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Matt England.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on April 3, 2023. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.

Matt England representing the Auburn Boy Scouts Troop #101 spoke to the Fourth of July Parade. Staging begins in the Meadows Subdivision, off Auburn Road, at 10:15 AM and the parade will kick off at 11:00 AM.

Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a March report of calls.

Michael S. Troyan conceded his time.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported the grading phase of the extended parking lot is complete at the Auburn Community Park. Phase II will start shortly.

The Trustees discussed correspondence received from Northeast Ohio Public Energizing Council, NOPEC. Every two years NOPEC gives members the opportunity to opt-out of their aggregation program.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to remain in the aggregation program and a member of NOPEC. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.

The Trustees discussed the Department of Agriculture (DOA) insect survey composed from data captured at Auburn Community Park. Emerick Gordon will be the Auburn contact person for the DOA.

Daniel J. Matsko, Deputy Fiscal Officer, presented a Payment Report listing payments warrants 44-2023 through 49-2023 and 7715 through 7762 for a total of \$119,349.83.

Mr. Matsko spoke to the collection of an insurance claim submitted in 2018 for damage to the fire station and communication tower. We received \$23,682.37 for the building repairs and \$76,140.00 for loss of the communication tower totaling \$99,822.37. Inadvertently, the money was never transferred to the Fire Fund.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to transfer the entire amount of \$99,822.37 to the Fire Fund and issue a check in the amount of \$76,140.00 to AVFD. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to accept the recommendation of the Geauga County Engineer and contract with Cole Burton Contractors, LLC in the amount of \$719,975.00 for the 2023 Asphalt of Various Roads in Auburn Township. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.

The Trustees discussed a recommendation to update the smoke alarms in the Administration building. Chief Phillips will research the matter.

Emerick Gordon submitted a quote from Weaver Tree.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to contract with Weaver Tree in the amount of \$6,425.00 to remove marked trees on Franks and Valley Roads. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes. The motion passed.







This CONTRACT is made and entered into at the Auburn Township Town Hall,
Geauga County, Ohio by and between the
Auburn Township Board of Trustees, Party of the First Part, hereinafter called the "Owner"
and Cole Burton Contractors, LLC Party of the Second, hereinafter called the "Contractor".

WITNESSETH, THAT the Contractor and the Owner for the consideration stated herein
agree as follows:

ARTICLE I - SCOPE OF THE WORK

The Contractor shall perform everything required to be performed and shall provide and furnish all of the labor, materials, necessary tools, expendable equipment, and all utility and transportation services required to perform and complete in a workmanlike manner all the work required and called for on the Plans and described in the Description of Work and in conformance with the General Clauses and Covenants for the project entitled

Auburn Township, Geauga County

all in strict accordance with the Plans and Specifications including any and all Addenda, prepared by the Geauga County Engineer, acting and hereinafter referred to as the "Engineer", and the Contractor shall do everything required by this Contract and the other documents constituting a part hereof.

ARTICLE II - COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE CONTRACTOR

In consideration of the completion of the work described herein and the fulfillment of all stipulations of the Contract to the satisfaction and acceptance of the Engineer and the Owner, the Owner shall pay and the said Contractor further agrees to receive and accept payment based on the bid prices as set forth in the confirmed copy of the Contractor's Proposal hereto attached, with the total payment reduced by accepted deductions set forth, which prices and deductions shall agree with those in the accepted Contractor's Proposal as full compensation for furnishing all the equipment and materials and for the costs of all premiums on insurance and bonds and for doing all the work contemplated and specified in this Contract; also for all the work arising out of the nature of the work aforesaid, or from the actions of the elements, or from any unforeseen obstructions or difficulties which may be encountered in the prosecution of the same; and for all risks of every description connected with the work; and for well and faithfully completing the work and the whole thereof, in full compliance with the Plans and Specifications and the requirements of the Engineer under them.

Payments are to be made to the Contractor in accordance with and subject to the provisions embodied in the Contract Documents hereto attached or incorporated herein by reference.

ARTICLE IV - MISCELLANEOUS


- A. The Contractor acknowledges that he has not received or relied upon any representations or warranties of any nature whatsoever from the Owner, its agents or employees, and that this Contract is entered into solely upon the Contractor's own independent business judgment. The Contractor acknowledges that it is performing its duties and obligations under this contract as an independent contractor.
- B. The parties agree that the law of the State of Ohio shall control with regard to any and all contractual disputes that may arise and that any and all contractual litigation undertaken or arising under this Contract shall be presented in a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of Geauga County, Ohio.
- C. The parties agree that this is the sole and exclusive agreement of the parties and that any necessary modification be reduced to writing and executed in a like manner.
- D. If any covenant or provision of this Contract or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation or to any circumstance, shall to any extent be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or application of such covenant or provision to persons, firms or corporations or to circumstances other than those to which it is invalid or unenforceable, shall not be effected thereby.
- E. In hiring employees for the performance of work under this contract or any subcontract, no contractor or subcontractor shall, by reason of race, color, religion, sex, age, handicap, national origin, or ancestry, discriminate against any citizen of this state in the employment of a person qualified and available to perform the work to which this contract relates. No contractor, subcontractor, or any person acting on behalf of any contractor or subcontractor shall, in any manner, discriminate against, intimidate, or retaliate against any



employee hired for the performance of work under this contract on account of race, color, religion, sex, age, handicap, national origin, or ancestry.

- F. The Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and save harmless the Owner, its officers, agents and employees from all claims, demands, payments, suits, actions, recoveries, and judgments of every description, whether or not founded in law, brought or recovered against it, to include reimbursement of any fees or cost incurred by the Owner and in the defense of any claims against the Owner arising from the conduct of the Contractor pursuant to the terms of this contract, by reason of any negligent act or omission of said Contractor, his agents or employees, in the execution of this Contract or in consequence of insufficient protection, or for the use of any patented invention by said Contractor.
- G. The Contractor shall at all times during the life of the Contract, subscribe to and comply with the Worker’s Compensation laws of the State of Ohio and pay such premiums as may be required thereunder and to save the Owner harmless from any and all liability arising from, out of, or under said act. He shall also furnish at the time of delivery of this Contract and at such times as may be requested, a copy of the official certificate or receipt showing the payment hereinbefore referred to.
- H. The Contractor agrees that it is an independent contractor with respect to the Owner and not an agent or employee of the Owner.
