The Regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Patrick J. Cavanagh, Chairman, and also present were Trustees Eugene T. McCune, Jr. and Michael S. Troyan. Daniel J. Matsko, Fiscal Officer, was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Craig Sirna.

Michael Troyan reviewed the minutes of the June 19, 2023, meeting regarding the cemetery headstones.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune, Jr., seconded by Michael Troyan, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on June 19, 2023. VOTE: McCune, yes; Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

SCHEDULED REPORTS:

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector – Twenty-two zoning permits issued in June, 2023. There were four denials for zoning permits. These could result in a variance request or a conditional use. A building in front of a house is against Auburn Township zoning. In-ground swimming pools, zoning requires a fence as well as insurance companies require a fence. Mr. Cavanagh stated the Auburn Township Zoning Commission was pretty thorough with the swimming pool zoning.

For agricultural buildings where no zoning permit was issued or inspections done, Claridon Township will not insure the damage from a fire or roof collapse. The Geauga County Building Department will not inspect an agricultural building. Jane, Zoning Secretary, and Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, are dealing with this issue.

Mike Ludwig, Township Highway Department – Senior Trash Day was two days and it was very busy. It was another good event and 100 seniors requested trash pick up managed by four crews. Roadside mowing is being done. Mulch for the playground and finer sand for the volleyball court. Truck 16 hydraulic work completed. The asphalt resurfacing of Longview Trail, Bridge Creek Trail, Frostwood Trail, Golden Pond Drive, and Sanctuary Drive are 35 – 40 day projects. Letters were sent out to the residents. Patrick J. Cavanagh stated the township was trying to accommodate the residents with graduation parties.

Auburn Township 2023-2025 Headstone Restoration Program – Patrick J. Cavanagh stated that Auburn Community Church had donated \$75,000 for cemetery maintenance (restoration) of headstones. It was a really nice gift from the church. Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration, LLC, Nashville, IN has done restoration of headstones for Munson and Troy Townships. The estimates dated November 28, 2022, for both cemeteries were reviewed by the Board. The townships two cemeteries – Shadyside and Maple Shade have headstones which need to be restored. Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration, LLC will be here in August – September, 2023 to restore the headstones as outlined in the Township's headstone restoration program and the estimate submitted by Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration, LLC. Patrick J. Cavanagh stated the restoration program will be stretched out over three years with \$25,000 being allocated annually. The 2023 completed restoration work will be looked at, and a decision made on work to be done next year. Michael Troyan stated the process will consist of hand digging or using a machine for new foundations and clean up.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh, seconded by Michael Troyan, to contract with Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration, LLC for cemetery monument restoration as described here for the first portion of Phase I for \$26,000. VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes; and McCune, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh, seconded by Eugene T. McCune, Jr. to adopt the following Resolution for a Certificate of Need to levy an additional tax outside of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of Road Improvement at a rate of 1 mill for five years which levy is a renewal. VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; McCune, yes; and Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

CERTIFICATE OF NEED – WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Auburn Twp, Geauga County, Ohio, has determined the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Auburn Twp and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of ORC 5705.19 (G) for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in municipal corporations, counties, or townships; in Auburn Twp as provided authorized in Ohio Revised Code Section ORC 5705.19 (G), and

WHEREAS, the levy is at a rate of 1.00 mills for each one dollar of taxable value, for a PERIOD OF 5 YEAQRS and is an renewal of an existing 1.00 mill levy first voted on in 2005; and WHEREAS, the ballot measure shall be submitted to the ENTIRE TOWNSHIP and the tax shall be levied on the ENTIRE TOWNSHIP and within GEAUGA COUNTY; WHEREAS, the levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on November 7, 2023, and shall first be levied in tax year 2023 and begin collection in 2024.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Auburn Twp, Geauga County, Ohio, that based on the foregoing and pursuant to R.C. 5705.03(B), said board hereby certifies this Resolution to the Geauga County Auditor, and requests that the County Auditor certify back to the Board of Trustees the amounts described in R.C. 5705.03(B)(2) that would be generated by the levy proposed herein.

- **Quotes received from Fogarty Services to pressure wash and cleaning exterior windows for the following buildings: Parker Bldg. - \$430; Adam Hall - \$549; Administration Bldg. - \$522; Town Hall - \$450. Total of \$1951.00.**

Patrick J. Cavanagh discussed the Quotes 1082 – 1085 from Fogarty Services for pressure washing and cleaning exterior windows. The Board reviewed the quotes. The east wall of the Administration Building needs some work.

Motion by Michael Troyan, seconded by Eugene T. McCune, Jr. to contract with Fogarty Services for the power washing and cleaning of exterior windows for the aforementioned buildings. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; and Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

- **Quote received from Cable Communications - \$3,232.04 – Installation of data cabinet, data cables, clean-up of old wiring needed for new internet phones and updated network system per the Geauga County IT Department.**

Patrick J. Cavanagh stated the cable at the Road Garage is being updated. A new data cabinet, data cables, and clean-up of wiring for the new internet phones. Also, it appears that something additional is requested at every meeting, and he hoped this is getting to the end of the requests. Michael Troyan agreed a new cabinet will be less prone to dust and moisture. The Service Garage was not a part of the initial updating of the network. Everything is going into one system, and the County IT Department is doing good work.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune, Jr., seconded by Michael Troyan, to accept the Auburn Township Service Center Data Cabling as submitted by Cable Communications, Inc. VOTE: McCune, yes; Troyan, yes; and Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

- **Quote received from Buckeye Power Sales – Service Garage Generator Repair**
The generator at the Service Garage failed two to three weeks ago. The cost of ten spark plugs which is included in the bill was \$1,574.30.

Motion by Michael Troyan, seconded by Eugene T. McCune, Jr. to accept the quote to repair the service garage generator. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; and Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS:

Michael Troyan reported that the Boy Scouts and the Fire Department did a great job working on the 4th of July parade together. This was the first year for the Boy Scouts, and just a few things need to be worked on. The parade was larger with a lot more people attending. There were 200 people or more.

Eugene T. McCune, Jr. stated he distributed 60 lbs. of candy and ran out. He wanted to thank Matt England for his help in organizing the parade. It was very impressive, and the parade gets bigger and nicer every year.

There were 300 hot dogs and brats sold this year. The Boy Scouts cleared just over \$700.

Michael Troyan on a sad note for the Township discussed the passing of Jack Trethewey, who was a member of the Board of Zoning Appeals for 20 years and offered his condolences to the family. Also, Mark Roubic another dedicated Auburn Township resident passed away. It was a tough week for Auburn Township to lose two caring township residents.

Patrick J. Cavanagh stated that both gentlemen were dedicated to the township. Zeke, Trethewey
Auburn Township Fire Department, was another sad passing.


The Auburn Township Trustees cannot legally promote the levy. If there is a Candidate's Night, the issue can be discussed. The Auburn Township residents have been very generous and very supportive of levies.


Craig Sirna, Auburn Township resident, was recognized. Mr. Sirna is concerned with the road closures in Auburn Township and the effect it is having on local businesses. Various small businesses have taken a big hit – Hitching Post for one. When a road is totally shut down, the local businesses suffer. Patrick J. Cavanagh stated the County Engineer plans the road projects two to three years in advance. Mr. Sirna was asking for partial closures. Replacing a bridge is tough and cannot be a partial closure. Having two-way traffic, helped Mr. Sirna survive. A portion of Rte. 44 in Auburn Township will be closed for 14 days. In Middlefield, Rte. 608 was open for buggies and businesses. Patrick J. Cavanagh will talk to the County Engineer regarding partial road closures instead of total road closures.

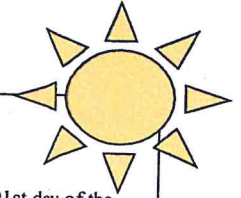

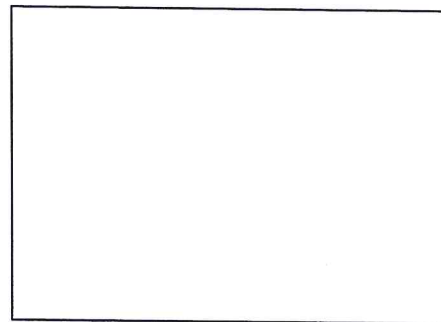


