The Public Hearing on the Auburn Township 2024 Proposed Tax Budget was called to order at 7:15 P.M. by Patrick J. Cavanagh, Chairman, and also present were Trustees Eugene T. McCune, Jr. and Michael S. Troyan. Daniel J. Matsko, Fiscal Officer, was absent due to a scheduled vacation booked in 2022. Chairman Cavanagh introduced Joan Windnagel who was taking the minutes for the Fiscal Officer.

Chairman Cavanagh stated the public hearing on the 2024 Proposed Tax Budget is set by State Statute and is required. There is a Road & Bridge Tax Levy on the ballot this Fall. It is a renewal and not included in the proposed tax budget. You cannot assume the levy is going to pass. The Road and Bridge Fund should never have a negative balance.

Eugene T. McCune, Jr. inquired about the monies from the Auburn Community Church, now defunct, one check for \$75,000 earmarked for cemetery headstone restoration; and one check for \$75,000 for the Museum totaling \$150,000. The monies were received several years ago, and which fund the former fiscal officer deposited the monies was unclear. Are the funds in an investment account? In the Fall of 2021, there were a set of motions for these donations. The data entry on the UAN Computer will be easy to find to confirm the deposit of the monies and the fund.

The Auburn Township 2024 Proposed Tax Budget is posted on the website, and the legal notice was published with the public hearing date. The public hearing needed to be held by July 15.

At 7:30 P.M., a motion by Mr. Eugene T. McCune, Jr., seconded by Mr. Michael Troyan, to close the public hearing of the 2024 Auburn Township Proposed Tax Budget.
VOTE: McCune, yes; Troyan, yes; and Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.
