The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Patrick J. Cavanagh. All Trustees were present.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the minutes of the PUBLIC HEARING held on June 10, 2023. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

REPORTS:

Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 284 calls in 2023 to 254 calls in 2022. The percentage of multiple calls was 25.49% for January – June 2023. He reported the annual fire department clam bake is scheduled for Saturday, September 23rd.

Michael S. Troyan has been out of the township lately and had nothing to report so he yielded his time.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported the generator at Adam Hall is installed but not yet hooked up. The meter needs changed out. He noted a new layer of playground mulch has been installed and the playground meets safety standards.




Daniel J. Matsko, Deputy Fiscal Officer, presented a July Payment Report, listing payments 88-2023, through 97-2023, and warrants 7877 through 7923 for a total of \$170,706.38. He read a letter from Assistant Prosecutor, Krissy Rine in response to donations from Auburn Church two years ago. He noted that research is in progress to create Capital Project Funds.


Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to adopt Resolution 2023-24 Declaring it Necessary to levy a tax in excess of the 10 mill Limitation for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in municipal corporations, counties, or townships per the ORC 5705.19(G) at a rate of 1.00 mills for a period of 5 years and is a renewal of an existing levy first voted in 2005. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.
