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The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Patrick J. Cavanagh. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chief Phillips.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on August 21, 2023. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

REPORTS:

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, submitted a zoning report reflecting 8 applications processed in the month of August resulting in 8 permits issued. He spoke to complaints of drones invading privacy in subdivisions. Regulation of drones falls under the FAA. It is a felony to shoot a drone out of the sky. Mr. Kitko also reported the request of a personal burial on private property. It is legal under Ohio law.

Emerick Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent, gave the following report for August:

- The resurfacing of Bridge Creek Tr., Longview Tr., Frostwood Dr., Sanctuary Dr. and Golden Pond were completed, and punch list items satisfied.
- The Crack Seal Program has been finished to satisfactory results, including all roads on the supplied schedule.
- Spot ditching projects were completed on Robin Wood Ln., Thorpe Rd. and Bartholomew Rd.
- Roadside mowing continued into early August and will be done again prior to winter service.
- Storm damage and downed trees were cleaned up around the township in several locations due to the August 24th and 25th weather events. As with all major weather events resident requests pour in, are logged and addressed according to priority.
- 25mph signs were replaced on Orange Ln., White Oak Dr. and Sanctuary Dr. as well as a 45mph sign replaced on Quinn Rd.

Mr. Gordon reported that truck #19 had to be towed in for repairs. The Service Department helped clean up after the last big storm event.

Michael S. Troyan represented the township and attended the ceremony to honor our First Responders at Kenston football game on September 1st. He noted West Geauga Kiwanis Club would like to sell tickets to their fundraiser at our community picnic. They are having a helicopter drop golf balls at the County Fairgrounds. Trustee Troyan reported franchise fees received.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to deposit franchise fees received from Charter Communications in the amount of \$5,300.56







BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of AUBURN TOWNSHIP⁹, Geauga County, Ohio, has determined the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of AUBURN TOWNSHIP¹⁰ and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of:

ORC 5705.19(G) For the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in municipal corporations, counties, or townships;

in AUBURN TOWNSHIP¹² as provided and authorized in Ohio Revised Code § OF RC 5705.19(G)¹³, and

The levy is at a rate of 1.00 mills for each one dollar of taxable value¹⁴, which amounts to \$25.00 dollars for each one hundred thousand dollars of the County Auditor's appraised value, for a PERIOD OF 5 YEARS¹⁵ and is a(n) RENEWAL¹⁶
RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING LEVY FIRST VOTED ON IN 2005¹⁷; and

The ballot measure shall be submitted to the ENTIRE TOWNSHIP¹⁸ and the tax shall be levied on the ENTIRE TOWNSHIP¹⁹ and within GEauga COUNTY²⁰, and

The levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on NOVEMBER 7, 2023²¹, and shall first be levied in tax year 2023²² and begin collection in 2024²³.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of the AUBURN TOWNSHIP²⁴ be and he/she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, along with Resolution 2023-22²⁵ and the certification from the County Auditor received pursuant to R.C. 5705.03(B)(2) to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio on or before AUGUST 9, 2023²⁶ by 4:00pm local time and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

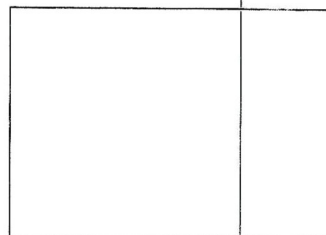
