The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Patrick J. Cavanagh. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by John Whitelock.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on October 2, 2023, with spelling correction for Mantua. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

REPORTS:

Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 683 calls in 2023 to 637 calls in 2022. The percentage of multiple calls was 26.20% for January –September 2023.

Michael S. Troyan had no report.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported he and Chief Phillips attended an Incident Response / Emergency Management Seminar at the new County Offices on October 10th. It was presented by ODOT.

Trustee McCune announced the passing of Al Hrabak at the age of 88.

Patrick J. Cavanagh had no report.

Daniel J. Matsko, Deputy Fiscal Officer, presented a payment report listing warrants 132-2023 through 138-2023 and warrants 8034 through 8053 for a total of \$64,789.72.

Mr. Matsko presented the Trustees a new health insurance plan from Hartford for employees that are currently using Medicare as their primary insurance. The Trustees asked if any other township besides Groveport City has Hartford's policy? The Trustees asked Mr. Matsko to set up a meeting between employees and Michelle Crockett, from Burnham & Flower Group Insurance, so that all their questions can be answered.

The Trustees interviewed John Whitelock for a possible 2024 zoning board opening.

OLD BUSINESS:

Taylor May speed study is under way. No update on the NOPEC grant.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Trustees discussed correspondence from NOPEC regarding the General Assembly Meeting in November.

The Trustees discussed correspondence from the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, advising The Pond Ice Rink has applied for a class C permit and inquiring if the Board requests a hearing on the advisability of issuing such permit. Trustee Cavanagh will check with the Geauga County Sheriff's office for prior issues before waiving the hearing.

PUBLIC COMMENT:



ADJOURNMENT:


