The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Patrick J. Cavanagh. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mario Manacci.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on November 20, 2023. VOTE: Troyan, yes; McCune, yes; Cavanagh, yes. The motion passed.

GUESTS:

Mario Manacci, AVFD Corporation President, presented the 2024 Fire Contract to the Board of Trustees for review prior to the County Prosecutor's review. Mr. Manacci gave a report listing the following FEMA/Mico Grants applied for and received in 2023:

- \$180,000 granted for 26 air packs with masks that have a 15 year life span.
- \$ 90,000 granted for battery powered extraction tools. The benefit to battery powered is not having to rely on hydraulic hoses and generators.

He reported they have received \$362,917.00 in grant money over the past 3 years. This includes training grants.

REPORTS:

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, gave a zoning report reflecting 4 applications processed in the month of November. He explained that variance requests that get denied by the Zoning Board of Appeals can progress slowly once turned over to our Prosecutor and the Chardon Courts.

Mr. Kitko removed advertising signs throughout the township from the road right-of-way. There was discussion between the Zoning Inspector and some residents regarding an issue on Messenger Road. He assured them he is monitoring the situation.

Emerick P. Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent, gave the following report for November:

- November saw 2 weather events that required 4 rounds of plowing and or salting. A total of 121 tons of deicing material was used. This brings the monthly average usage for November to 95 tons. We currently have ~ 1879 tons of road salt in our dome.
- Capital improvement projects for 2024 are being reviewed with the Geauga County Engineers. Edinboro Ln. has been added to the proposed paving list as per my discussions with Trustee P.J. Cavanagh and their office. Utilizing the OPWC grant of \$250,000 and interest free loan of \$150,000 payable within the lifecycle of the OPWC funded roads, this will bring the mileage of resurfacing to 2.64 miles and be below the \$700,000 budget as current numbers indicate. Any balance of budgeted funds will be earmarked for the reconstruction of Moreland Phase II subdivision scheduled for the 2025 construction season. Drainage and culverts will be addressed next spring / summer where needed.
- Patching was done on various roads and the asphalt hot box loaded with cold patch to prepare for winter potholes. One ditching project was finished on White Oak Dr. completing our residential ditching request list for the season. Any additional requests will be added to the list for next years' service.
- The new Western Star single axle dump truck should be ready for delivery before month's end and available for winter service.

Michael S. Troyan had no report.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported an electrical issue with the florescent lights at Town Hall. We are waiting for a quote from an electrician to fix it. Trustee McCune noted he will be attending the DARE Graduation at Kenston on Thursday, Dec. 14th.

Patrick J. Cavanagh reported correspondence was received from Chagrin River Watershed Partners noting a ~~53%~~ increase in membership dues. He also reported the Geauga County Sheriff's office notified us the hourly rate for a Deputy at Adam Hall in 2024 has increased to \$50 per hour.

Daniel J. Matsko, Deputy Fiscal Officer, presented a Reconciliation Report and Payment Report, listing warrants 157-2023 – 161-2023 and 8094 through 8113 for a total of \$238,220.25.

OLD BUSINESS:

The NOPEC Energizing Grant balance available is \$30,378.00.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Trustees discussed presented Resolution 2023-34 which is an amended Resolution 2023-33 which was passed at their meeting on 11/20/23.

Troyan to adopt Resolution 2023-34 authorizing the Fiscal Officer to make a written request to the Geauga County Auditor for the fiscal year 2024 tax advancement pursuant to the ORC. 321.34. 




The Trustees discussed franchise fees received.
