The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Michael S. Troyan. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Matt England.

**Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on May 6, 2024. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.**

**GUESTS:**

Matt England was present representing Auburn Boy Scout Troop 101 who is hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Picnic and Parade at the fire station. The parade will commence at 10:00am from the Meadows sub-division, off Auburn Road. Trustee McCune indicated it is a township event organized by the Boy Scouts, therefore, covered by township liability insurance.

There will be a website advertised for further information about the event. Chief Phillips will arrange for traffic control through the Sherriff's office and the Boy Scouts will handle the post parade picnic and donate profits to a Veteran's Association.

**SCHEDULED REPORTS:**

**Chief John Phillips, AVFD**, presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 300 year-to-date calls in 2024 to 298 calls in 2023. The percentage of multiple calls was 24.66% for January-April 2024 compared to 25.83% in 2023.

Chief Phillips reported the department is looking for a new vendor to give a quote for drilling a deeper well at the station.

**Eugene T. McCune Jr.** reported he met with the soil scientist at the park and is waiting on a report. Ohio Department of Natural Resources has paused the NatureWorks Grant Program.

Trustee McCune Jr. attended the annual Auburn School Alumni Reunion at Adam Hall. It was very well attended, and everyone had a great time. He presented a Proclamation to Robert Cavanagh from the Board of Trustees for the oldest living graduate of Auburn School.

**Patrick J. Cavanagh** reported John Szoka announced he will be retiring on September 1, 2024. Job postings will be needed for both him and Emerick Gordon's position.

**Dan Matsko, Fiscal Officer**, presented the payment listing for payments processed since May 7, 2024, listing 13 electronic payments processed (\$58,312.51) and 15 warrants processed (\$26,893.80) totaling \$85,206.31.

Mr. Matsko reported the hiring of an assistant to the fiscal office is on hold. The prosecutor's office indicated that there might be a conflict of interest with Christine Blaser also being the treasurer of the Auburn Volunteer Fire Department. An Advisory Opinion has been requested by Dan Matsko from the Ohio Ethics Commission.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Michael S. Troyan** reported the Fire Department annual clam bake is tentatively set for Saturday, September 21, 2024. The Community Picnic at Auburn Community Park will be pushed back to Saturday, 28, 2024.

Trustee Troyan received a quote from G. W. Construction for water damage repairs at Adam Hall Community Center. The Trustees postponed a decision on the repairs until the roof could be looked at for the source of the leak.

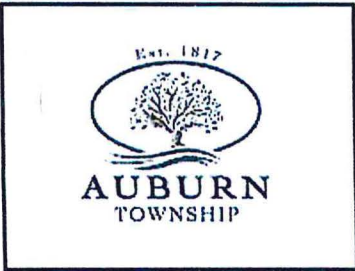

I, Daniel J Matsko Fiscal Officer of Auburn Township in Geauga County is requesting an advisory opinion of the Ohio Ethics Commission regarding my ability to hire a specific individual as my assistant while not posing a conflict of interest.

ORC 507.021 allows the township fiscal officer to hire and appoint one or more persons as the fiscal officer finds necessary to provide assistance to the township fiscal officer. Auburn Township advertised in the local newspaper for three separate weeks for such a person. This person would be limited to processing payables and receivables, timesheets for payroll processing and taking minutes at the board of trustees meeting in my absence. We received only one qualified applicant, the current treasurer of the Auburn Volunteer Fire Department.

Auburn Township currently has a contractual agreement with the Ohio non-profit corporation, Auburn Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. for the purpose of providing fire protection and emergency medical services for Auburn Township.

If hired this person would be a public employee while working for a private corporation that contracts with the township. In the Ohio Ethics Commission "Conflict of Interests Facts Sheet" under the heading **Public Servants and Outside Businesses:** *People who serve in the public sector often also have private outside businesses. Some may have a full or part-time job in addition to public service, some may do consulting work, or some may even own their own companies.*

*In most situations, the Ethics Law does not prohibit a public official or employee from engaging in private employment or business activity. However, a public official or employee must follow certain restrictions when working an outside job or running a business.*

Then listed are various restrictions prohibiting employees from doing. I did not see any instance where the future intended employee would benefit illegally or unethically by holding both positions.

None of the responsibilities performed as an assistant to the fiscal officer while treasurer of the fire department will require any decision making regarding the financial oversight of either organization.

Please advise specific to this situation if the township hiring the current treasurer of the Auburn Volunteer Fire Department while retaining that position would create a conflict of interest.
