The Regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman, Michael S. Troyan. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Emerick P. Gordon, Auburn Township Highway Superintendent.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees on June 13, 2024. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes, Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees on June 17, 2024. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes, Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees on June 25, 2024. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes, Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

REPORTS:

Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, submitted a zoning report reflecting 17 applications processed in the month of June. Two (2) of the 17 were applications to be presented to the Board of Zoning Appeals.

Emerick P. Gordon, Township Highway Superintendent, gave the following report for June:

- The paving projects, Bartholomew Rd., Quinn Rd., Edward Ln. and Edinboro Ln. started on schedule and were finished within the time frame stated in the contract.

 There were no major changes or issues with the installation of the new surfaces. With excellent communication between the engineer's office, the township and contractor the projects were completed in a timely fashion with little inconvenience to our residents.
- Berm repair was done at various locations as well as some ditching on Valley Rd. /
 ditching and residential requests will continue to be taken care of through the
 remainder of the construction season.
- There were two downed trees, one on Taylor May Rd. and one on Meadow Dr. that were blocking the roads and were removed and chipped.
- The roadside mower was out and fields at the community park were mowed also.
- Bleed through on the chip sealed roads was addressed and limestone screenings used to keep the tar down. This will continue as needed, typically on the hotter sunny days.

Mr. Gordon noted that the Auburn Township capital improvement projects were started on schedule and completed in a timely fashion.

Patrick J. Cavanagh addressed an invoice from Ronyak Paving, Inc. and the recommendation of the Geauga County Engineer to pay the first payment of \$302, 937.75. This was for work completed through June 14, 2024, for the *Asphalt Resurface of Various Roads in Auburn Township project*. He noted the total invoice amount was \$459,000.00, of which Auburn's portion was \$302,937.75, and the grant portion from the State of Ohio (OPWC) was \$156,062.25.

Trustee Cavanagh said the grant opportunity was due to Emerick Gordon's great relationship with the Geauga County Engineer. Auburn needed that capital improvement help, and he thanked Emerick for his help in securing it.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michael S. Troyan to accept the Geauga County Engineer's recommendation and pay Ronyak Paving, Inc. first payment for the Asphalt Resurface of Various Roads in Auburn Township in the amount of \$302,937.75. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported he scheduled a meeting with Chip Hess at Auburn Community Park on July 11, 2024, at 10:30am. to discuss the results of the soil and perk test and to finalize a location for the proposed septic. Trustee McCune requested another Trustee attend the meeting along with him, as well as a representative from the road department. Michael S. Troyan thought one Trustee at the meeting would be sufficient and concurred that someone from the road department attend that meeting as well.

Fiscal Officer, Dan Matsko, presented Resolution 2024-14 for the Supplemental Appropriation of \$491.87 to the Coronavirus Relief Fund to return unused money form the Cares Act.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to adopt Resolution 2024-14 for the Supplemental Appropriation of \$491.87 to the Coronavirus Relief Fund to return unused money from the Cares Act. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Michael S. Troyan asked about the NatureWorks grant for the proposed Auburn Community Park restroom facility. Mr. McCune Jr. said they are still waiting for the state to fund it.

Chairman Troyan addressed the pending G.W. Construction quote for repairs at Adam Hall. Patrick J. Cavanagh noted we are still waiting for Campopiano to submit a competitive quote. The Town Hall roof is scheduled for repair later this week by Campopiano, and hopefully soon after they will submit a report and quote for Adam Hall.

Michael Troyan explained they are looking into an expansion of the Shadyside Cemetery and have asked Hess & Associates Engineering. Inc., to look at the best direction to go. The plan in place is to complete the work in sections. Emerick Gordon noted he had a call into Hess and was waiting to hear back from him. Trustee McCune said he spoke to Hess about this, and will meet with him next Thursday, and will bring it up again.

NEW BUSINESS:

Patrick J. Cavanagh gave some background to the proposed Resolution 2024-14 Certificate of Need. Collection will cease on the 1 mill Road & Bridge levy that unexpectedly expired in 2020. This will leave a hole in the Road & Bridge budget.

Rather than throw a standard 1 mill road levy on the ballot, the Board will attempt to only address the shortfall in the fund. The Certificate of Need is for .65 mills which will generate approximately the same dollar amount that will no longer be collected.

NEW BUSINESS (continued):

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to adopt Resolution 2024-15 Certificate of Need determining the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Auburn Township and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges in municipal corporations, counties or townships; as provided and authorized in Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(G) at a rate of .65 mills for each one dollar of taxable value for a period of 5 years submitted to the entire township and shall be first levied in 2024 and first collected in 2025. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Patrick J. Cavanagh thanked the voters for their past support for the road levies and would appreciate their support to replace the expired levy and to continue to work the road program.

The Trustees discussed two upcoming open positions in the Road Department. Emerick Gordon's retirement, effective 8/1/24 and John Szoka retirement, effective 9/01/24. Tonight was Emerick's last meeting and Mr. Cavanagh thanked him for his 27 years of service to Auburn Township.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bob Brosnan addressed the Trustees regarding suggestions for developing his property at Rt 44 and Rt 422. He asked to have a work session with the Trustees to discuss what the community would like to see on this property. Mr. Brosnan shared that he spoke to different developers, and they seemed to have different opinions.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. asked if he spoke to the Auburn Township Zoning Inspector, Frank Kitko, to see what he could develop on his property. Mr. Kitko said the property was comprised of 3 different zoning districts. He suggested Mr. Brosnan meet with the Auburn Township Zoning Commission.

Trustee McCune Jr. and Trustee Cavanaugh agreed and addressed Mr. Brosnan that he starts his process with the Zoning Commission.

Bob Brosnan thanked the Trustees for their time. Michael Troyan added the next Zoning Commission meeting was on July 11, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.
