

Held _____ 20 _____

The meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Michael S. Troyan. All Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Michael S. Troyan.

MINUTE APPROVAL:

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on July 1, 2024, with written corrections. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes, Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

SCHEDULED REPORTS:

Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 480 year-to-date calls in 2024 to 455 calls in 2023. The percentage of multiple calls was 22.29% for January-June 2024 compared to 25.49% in 2023.

Chief Phillips reported the 4th of July parade went well; there was a good turnout.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported he and Mike Fenstermaker met Hess and Associates Engineering at Auburn Community Park to go over the proposed septic location. The site has to be approved by the EPA. After more discussion, they decided to bring back the soil testing company to do some more testing. Chip Hess thought it would be better to reroute some pipes. After the soil and water report comes back, they will work on a contract with Hess and Associates Engineering.

Patrick J. Cavanagh reported he is looking into windowsill repairs at the museum. The funding will come from the donation from the Auburn Community Church. When they closed their doors, they specifically donated to the maintenance of the museum. Cavanaugh felt the Township needed to do some work on the Museum, and thought the money earmarked from the church was to be used to increase access to the building.

Dan Matsko, Fiscal Officer, presented the payment listing for payments processed since July 1, 2024, listing 10 electronic payments processed (\$43,055.71) and 19 warrants processed (\$203,320.67) totaling \$246,376.38.

At the Special Public Hearing on the 2025 Tax Budget Fiscal Officer Dan Matsko presented a Summary of the Budget Revenues and Expenses noting some of the significant changes.

He presented the following Resolutions: 2024-17 Reallocation of Inside Millage for 2025; 2024-18 Reduce Gasoline Tax Appropriation for remainder of 2024; and 2024-19 Approval of 2025 Budget.

Patrick J. Cavanagh had a discussion with Nancy Dolezal about how hard it is to find hall representatives for Adam Hall. Matt Blowers has been very reliable, but he is starting to travel more frequently. In the past, Nancy Dolezal and Jane Hardy have stepped up and took over some hours, but the Township really needs to hire someone. Matt will continue to do the cleaning; a hall representative needs to be hired. Bainbridge Township has had an ad in the paper for a few weeks now looking for hall reps and is offering \$17 - \$20 per hour. Discussion ensued.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve a \$20.00 an hour rate for the position of Hall Representative for Adam Hall effective immediately. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Trustees discussed two open positions in the Road Department. Ads are being run in the Geauga Maple Leaf and The Chagrin Valley Times with an application deadline of August 18th. Salary is not listed in ad, CDL preferred is stated. Trustee Cavanagh noted a survey was conducted of Geauga township roadworkers and shared with Auburn. It appears that Auburn Township is right in line with everyone's salary.

NEW BUSINESS:

Michael S. Troyan read aloud Resolution 2024-16.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to adopt Resolution 2024-16 Declaring it Necessary to Levy a Tax in Excess of the Ten Mill Limitation VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Michael S. Troyan to adopt Resolution 2024-17 to Reallocate Inside Millage and change the inside millage allocation effective January 1, 2025, to 3.0 inside General Fund and 0.0 inside Road & Bridge. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to adopt Resolution 2024-18 for the following Supplemental Appropriation: (\$200,000.00) Supplemental Appropriation from Special Revenue Fund GASOLINE TAX – 2021-330-360-0000 CONTRACTED SERVICES in order to increase January 1, 2025 Projected Fund Balance for the 2025 Budget. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh approve Resolution 2024-19 Adopting the Auburn Township Budget for the Fiscal year 2025 as presented on the financial worksheet attached hereto and made part of this Resolution. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr. seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh to approve the recommendation of the Geauga County Engineer's office and adopt the house number assignment, 16316 Munn Road, recommended for Parcel #01-106000 per Auburn Township Resolution 2024-09 requested by William Timmons. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the final Change Order representing a decrease of \$18,669.90 from the contracted awarded amount for the Asphalt Resurface of Various Roads in Auburn Township. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to act upon the recommendation of the Geauga County Engineer and pay Ronyak Paving Inc. final payment of \$161,134.50 for the Asphalt Resurface of Various Roads in Auburn Township. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Diane Jones asked why the township is transferring funds from Road & Bridge to the General Fund. Patrick J. Cavanagh explained that the Township is obligated by State law to refund the money that was erroneously collected. The Auditor / Budget Commission had some discretion as to how to get that money back from the Township. In this case, they wanted one lump sum – ASAP. Cavanaugh went on to say even though that money was spent from the Road and Bridge fund, they can't take the money out of that fund – it had to be taken from the General Fund. That is in the ORC (Ohio Revised Code.) Anything that is dedicated to Road and Bridge, must be spent on Road and Bridge. Cavanaugh stated this was how the Auditor wants to collect the money back from the Township, so they can't put the money in Road and Bridge – it had to be pulled from the General Fund.

Michael S. Troyan and Dan Matsko also added to the explanation. Eugene T. McCune Jr. added that this helps Geauga County - they want their money now – not in 3 to 5 years. McCune said if they could have worked out payments with the County, they would have, but they want all of their money, including interest, now. Troyan added the County wanted their money right away, because they were paying it back right away (to the taxpayers.) McCune said the money would be taken in the first quarter of next year. Cavanaugh noted the County Prosecutor said this situation was “unprecedented.”


Diane Jones also asked if the proposed 2025 Budget is available online. Fiscal Officer, Dan Matsko, advised her it has been online since July 5, 2024, just as it was stated in the legal ad. It is also posted on the bulletin board at Auburn Township Administration office and is posted on the official township website.

WHEREAS, the Board has received the certification from the County Auditor pursuant to R.C. 5705.03(B)(2), and the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Auburn Township ¹, Geauga County, Ohio;

The levy is at a rate of .65 ⁹ mills for each one dollar of taxable value, which amounts to \$23.00 ¹⁰ dollars for each one hundred thousand dollars of the County Auditor's appraised value, for a period of 5 years ¹¹ and is a(n) additional levy ¹² _____ ¹³; and

The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire township ¹⁴ and the tax shall be levied on the entire township ¹⁵ and within Gauga County ¹⁶; and

The levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on November 5, 2024 ¹⁷, and shall first be levied in tax year 2024 ¹⁸ and begin collection in 2025 ¹⁹.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of the Auburn Township¹ be and he/she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, along with Resolution 2024-15²⁰ and the certification from the County Auditor received pursuant to R.C. 5705.03(B)(2) to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio on or before 08/07/2024²¹ by 4:00pm local time and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

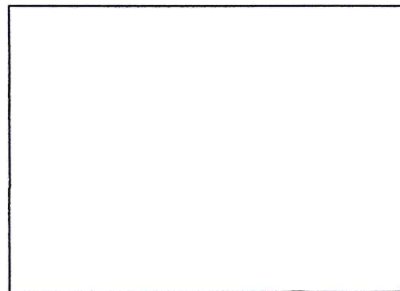
