

The regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Trustee Chairman Michael S. Troyan. All three Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Road Superintendent Michael Fenstermaker.

GUESTS:

Auburn resident, Cara Wood expressed her support for Issue 3 a Proposed (Additional) Tax Levy for the Kenston Local School District. Trustee Eugene McCune stated that taxes collected will be for the sole purpose of general permanent improvements only. Most school districts have this type of levy Mr. McCune added.

Auburn resident Marla Lucarelli asked if the township would request a speed/traffic study on Munn Rd. between Washington Street and Crackel Rd. After some discussion Mr. Cavanagh suggested the study extend to Bell Road as well.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan, seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh, to send a letter to the Geauga County Engineer requesting a speed/traffic study on Munn Rd. between Bell Road and Crackel Road. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Mr. Troyan had a letter already prepared to send to the Geauga County Engineer. All three trustees signed the letter.

SCHEDULED REPORTS:

Fire Chief John Phillips, AVFD, presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 781 year to date EMS & Fire Calls in 2024 to 683 calls in 2023. The percentage of multiple calls was 22.40% for January-September 2024 compared to 26.20% for the same period in 2023.

Chief Phillips submitted Requisition #703, for the drilling of a new water well for the fire department with estimates from multiple vendors totaling \$21,440.00. This requisition is intended to replace Requisition #697 for \$36,875.00 submitted on May 6, 2024 due to the original vendor not being able to perform the work because of health reasons. This search for a new vendor resulted in a savings of \$15,435.00.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan, seconded by, Eugene T. McCune Jr., to rescind the motion made on May 6, 2024 to approve Requisition #697. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan, seconded by, Eugene T. McCune Jr., to approve Requisition # 703 and the \$21,440.00 expenditure for a new water well to be drilled at the Auburn Fire Station. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion passed.

TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS:

Trustee Eugene McCune Jr. reported on progress with the wastewater treatment system project for Auburn Community Park. He stated that no work could start until spring of 2025. Mr. McCune recommended sending the Hess & Hess proposal to ADA Kristen Rine for review.

His attendance enabled Mr. Matsko to earn CPIM credits and Auditor of State FIA credit hours per ORC Section 135.22 - Annual continuing education programs for treasurers.



RESOLUTION 2024-24

RESOLUTION OF CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY FOR
THE IMPROVEMENTS OF VARIOUS ROADS

Auburn Township, Geauga County, Ohio

WHEREAS, the Auburn Township Board of Trustees (the Board) has determined that the public convenience and welfare require the improvement of **Moreland Trail from Stafford Road to cul-de-sac, Cooper Court from Moreland Trail to cul-de-sac, Jensen Court from Moreland Trail to cul-de-sac, and Regal Place from Valley Road to cul-de-sac** in Auburn Township, and to authorize the Geauga County Engineer to prepare engineering plans in accordance with Section 5573.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by a unanimous vote of the Board that the public convenience and welfare requires the improvement by repairing the existing pavement and embankments, replacing culverts, improving drainage structures, asphalt resurfacing, subgrade stabilization, stabilizing the shoulders, and related improvements, as necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Geauga County Engineer is hereby directed to make such surveys, plans, profiles, cross sections, estimates and specifications as are required for the improvement and to transmit copies of the same to this board.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the costs and expenses of said improvement shall be apportioned as follows:

The right of way costs, if any, and the construction costs for the project shall be paid from local funding sources and state grants and/or loan funds should they be available for this project. The engineering will be provided by the Geauga County Engineer at no cost to the Township.






