The regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Trustee Chairman Michael S. Troyan. All three Trustees were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by resident Deb Standley.

GUESTS:

There were no guests scheduled.

MINUTE APPROVAL:

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr., seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on December 16, 2024. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes; Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes. The motion PASSED.

SCHEDULED REPORTS:

Mike Fenstermaker, Township Highway Superintendent, presented the following report for December:

- There were fourteen weather events for the start of 2024/2025 snow season, requiring thirty-three rounds of plowing and or salting. Deicing material totaled 866 tons leaving approximately 850 tons of salt left in the dome. Several of events were minor with a few inches of snow to clean up. We did have some events that required several rounds due to the amount of snow.
- We excavated an area on the southwest corner of the building for the new diesel fuel and gas tanks. The new tanks are in place and the concrete barriers should be in place this week.
- On December 29th due to high winds, we had trees down at Bartholomew Road near Auburn Road, Snow Road and Taylor May Road near Quinn Road.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported that he attended the D.A.R.E (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) graduation for the 5th grade class at Kenston Intermediate School on Thursday, December 19, 2024.

Mr. McCune reported that he attended the Geauga County Board of Revision meeting with Trustee Patrick Cavanagh and Fiscal Officer Dan Matsko held on December 30, 2024.

Patrick J. Cavanagh reported that the water heater at the Town Hall is leaking and needs to be replaced. A plumber is scheduled to arrive on Tuesday January 7th.

Mr. Dan Matsko, Fiscal Officer, presented the payment listing for payments processed since December 16, 2024 - listing 12 electronic payments processed for \$39,111.58, and 16 warrants processed for \$10,424.58 totaling \$49,536.16.

Mr. Matsko presented the December bank reconciliation and savings account balances totaling \$2,656,042.45 as of December 31, 2024. Primary Checking account balance \$473,520.24; Star Ohio balance \$2,182,522.21.

Mr. Matsko asked if the trustees had an opportunity to review the draft of the letter sent by the County Auditor's Office resulting from the Board of Revision Meeting. The letter will be sent to all Auburn Township residents with the refund check explaining the reason for the tax overpayment including interest. They said they had and were pleased that any questions will be directed to the County Auditor's office.

Mr. Matsko presented a letter to Waste Management drafted by Administrative Assistant Nancy Dolezal requesting cancellation of the township weekly dumpster service contract. A monthly quote for significantly less money for the same service from Dumpster Bandit was the reason. There were many favorable comments from the audience regarding the service they receive from Dumpster Bandit.







On December 29th due to high winds, we had trees down at Bartholomew Road near Auburn Road, Snow Road and Taylor May Road near Quinn Road.
