Chief John Phillips, Auburn Fire Department, presented a Year-to-Date Fire and EMS Statistics Report comparing 1053 Total Calls in 2024 to 894 calls in 2023. An increase of 159 calls. The total number of EMS patients were 700 in 2024. An increase of 162 from the previous year.

Frank Kitko Auburn, Township Zoning Inspector, presented a Zoning Report for December 2024. Mr. Kitko pointed out that 12 applications for Single Family Dwellings were received in 2024 and 35 applications for Residential Accessory Buildings over 200 square feet.

Keith Blaser, Secretary, Auburn Fire Department, requested to discuss the appointments of the final three members to the Volunteer Firefighters Dependency Board. Two members of the fire department have already been appointed.

Motion by Eugene T. McCune Jr., seconded by Michael S. Troyan, to appoint Eugene McCune Jr., Patrick J. Cavanagh, and resident Carl Schneider to the Volunteer Firefighters Dependency Board. VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Michael S. Troyan had nothing to report.

Patrick J. Cavanagh reported that 1,500 tons of salt have been used so far this winter. Mr. Cavanagh made a quick inspection of the Auburn Township Museum and reported that he noticed no apparent damage.

TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS: (continued):

Eugene T. McCune mentioned that at the Geauga County Township Quarterly Dinner Meeting the Geauga Park District reported that Beartown Lakes Reservation established 10 years ago is scheduled to undergo some improvements in 2025. New restrooms, playgrounds, a lake overlook, and a shelter upgrade are some of the changes mentioned.

Daniel J. Matsko, Fiscal Officer, presented the payment listing for payments processed since January 6, 2025 - 15 electronic payments processed for \$65,507.56, and 18 warrants processed for \$14,900.52 totaling \$80,408.08.

Mr. Matsko reported on receiving a quote from the Geauga County ADP that indicated the townships Microsoft 365 annual user license fees were increasing significantly due to security concerns. He has asked the county for additional information needed to further review the quote.

Mr. Matsko reported that the Fund Status report as of January 1, 2025, showed that the township is carrying over \$2,655,193.45 into this year. Most noticeably is the \$1,014,639.35 in the Road and Bridge Fund. He indicated that Road Department liaison Patrick Cavanagh and the past and current road superintendents have done a remarkable job managing costs in anticipation of a significant road project scheduled for this year. Mr. Cavanagh concurred that had been the plan over the past few years.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chairman Eugene McCune reported on status of the notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control regarding the request to waive a hearing for the renewal of a liquor license to The Original Sandwich King.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan and seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh, to waive the request to hold a hearing for the renewal of a liquor license to The Original Sandwich King. VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.
