The Regular Meeting of the Zoning Commission was called to order at 7:35 PM by Chairman Ted Van Hyning.

The Commission reviewed the meeting minutes from November 14, 2024, meeting.

The Secretary and Commission also signed the paperwork for the Submission of Recommendation to the Auburn Township Board of Trustees. The Amendment will now be forwarded to the Trustees for their action.

Frank Kitko, Auburn Township Zoning Zoning Inspector, commented that he wanted to thank the Zoning Commission members for working on these amendments. Mr. Kitko explained that there have been concerns for himself and the zoning department. He commented that the accessory building height used to be 18 feet and it was changed to 23 feet and now back to 18 feet. Mr. Kitko explained that when the change was made to 23 feet, we created an issue with accessory buildings having living quarters. He indicated that there are 25-50 of these structures in the Township and they can be a health and safety issue because they are not built to specs for human habitation. He also indicated that in the past year the BZA has heard 3-4 cases for height issues. He also explained that the Township use to get help from the Building and Health Department with this, but basically the Health Department is gone and the Building Department is short-handed. Mr. Kitko again commented thank you for changing this.

Mr. Kitko also commented on food trucks that something needed to be put in place for health and safety and that is what the Commission did. He further commented that adjustments can be made if necessary.

There were no further comments regarding the amendments.

There was no Old Business on the agenda.

Mr. Van Hying indicated that the next meeting will be Thursday, January 9, 2025, and will be the Organizational Meeting.

Motion by Scott Brockman to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Jeff Pulsford. Vote: Brockman, yes; Lackey, yes; Daugherty, yes; Pulsford, yes; and Van Hying, yes. The motion was approved.
