The regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Trustee Chairman Eugene T. McCune Jr. Also in attendance were Trustees Patrick J. Cavanagh and Michael S. Troyan.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by AVFD Fire Chief John Phillips.

GUESTS:

Bill Amour, Auburn Township resident who lives on Whisper Woods Circle reported that the gaps between the concrete slabs in their road have widened and need filled in. Some discussion ensued among the trustees and Mr. Amour regarding the type of repair needed. Trustee Patrick Cavanagh said they will investigate the situation and fill in the joints with asphalt as they do every year. Mr. Cavanagh later pointed out that 12 years have passed since any major repairs were done to the road. Trustee Eugene McCune commented that the township has had to adjust the five-year road plan due to escalating costs and availability of funds.

MINUTE APPROVAL:

Motion by Michael S. Troyan, seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees held on March 3, 2025.
VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; Troyan, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

SCHEDULED REPORTS:

Auburn Fire Department Chief John Phillips presented the monthly detailed report for the Auburn Fire Department. He presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 162 year-to-date total calls in 2025 to 144 total calls in 2024. The percentage of multiple calls was 17.28% for January-February 2025 compared to 29.86% in 2024.

TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS:

Mr. Michael S. Troyan had nothing to report.

Mr. Patrick J. Cavanagh had nothing to report that was not on the agenda.

Eugene T. McCune Jr. reported that he attended a recent meeting of the Geauga County Board of Health. Two people were picked to fill a two-year term concluding in March 2027, and a five-year term concluding in March 2030. Five people applied for the job and were interviewed by the Board. Lynn Roman was selected for the two-year term, and Christine Sutter for the five-year term.

Mr. McCune Jr. also reported a snapshot of vital statistics in Geauga County, in a one-year period.

Birth certificates issued: 2283

Death certificates issued: 4759

Dog bites reported: 96

Mr. Dan Matsko, Fiscal Officer, presented the payment listing for payments processed since March 4, 2025 - listing 10 electronic payments processed for \$44,475.14, and 24 warrants processed for \$77,216.57 totaling \$121,691.71.

Mr. Matsko reported he, along with other Township Fiscal Officers attended a quarterly meeting where Geauga County Treasurer, Christopher Hitchcock presented historical financial data beneficial to township fiscal officers in preparing the 2026 budget. The budget is scheduled to be presented to the Geauga County Budget Commission in August of 2025.

Mr. Matsko said that Auburn Township received the first half real estate tax settlement from the Geauga County auditor. As predicted, \$752,041.72 was withheld to refund the township residents for funds collected in error on a 2005 1Mill R&B Levy.

Mr. Matsko shared a request from Jonathan Tiber – president of The Geauga County Township Association. Mr. Tiber is asking Geauga County Townships to consider sponsoring a high school student from their township entering their Junior or Senior year during the 2025-2026 academic year within their local school district. Cost is \$300 per student. Mr. Matsko asked the Board of Trustees if they were interested in sponsoring one or two students from Auburn Township. There was discussion among the Trustees and some questions arose about the legalities of this sponsorship.

Mr. McCune Jr. suggested they talk with the Geauga County Prosecutor and Janice Sugarman, Fiscal Officer for Bainbridge Township. Mr. Matsko said he would do that and report back to the Trustees at the next meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. McCune Jr. read aloud the two letters written to The Honorable Andrew O. Brenner, Ohio State Senator for District 19 and The Honorable Kristina D. Roegner, who is the Ohio State Senator for District 27. The letters expressed the Trustees perspective to opposing S.B. 104, as introduced. The legislation, as currently written, prohibits a township Board from adopting a ban on short-term rental properties or using zoning laws to prohibit or restrict short-term rentals in residential areas. Mr. McCune Jr. said that Mr. Cavanagh summed this up perfectly at the last Trustees meeting – that you are allowing someone to run a commercial business in a residential area.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. McCune Jr. said they received a quote from ‘Color Your World’ for painting Town Hall (\$1500) and Adam Hall (\$2250). It was noted that the Township already has the paint for Adam Hall. Mr. Matsko reported that they have a \$500 check for the deposit that will go out tomorrow.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan and seconded by Patrick J Cavanagh to hire Color Your World to paint Adam Hall for \$2250 and Town Hall for \$1500.
VOTE: Troyan, yes, Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Mr. McCune Jr said that they received a letter from Geauga Trumbull Gotta Go Green, stating that Auburn Township has been funded \$4,409 for the scrap tire grant, and enclosed a reimbursement request form. Mr. Cavanagh noted that the money comes after clean up day. Mr. McCune read that the reimbursement can be submitted from April 1 through November 30, 2025. The Trustees said the administrative assistant will submit the form.

McCune Jr. said they must appoint an OTARMA (Ohio Township Association Risk Management Authority) representative and alternate. It was the understanding of Mr. McCune Jr. that the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and the Fiscal Officer fill those positions. Mr. Matsko read the form aloud, requiring the members to appoint representatives.

Motion made by Patrick J. Cavanagh and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr., to list Fiscal Officer Daniel Matsko as the OTARMA representative and Eugene T. McCune Jr., Chairman of the Board of Trustees, as the alternate. VOTE: Troyan, yes, Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Mr. Matsko said that he was meeting with the Auburn Fire Department on May 7, 2025, to go over their budget, as well as their fiscal needs for 2026 and beyond.



Mr. Matsko asked the building liaison (Mr. McCune Jr.) if he could identify what repairs are needed and provide an estimated cost for the upcoming budget. Mr. McCune said he would have the information available sometime in April 2025.

Mr. Ryan also asked the Trustees if anything could be done about removing grapevines in the woods that could potentially harm the trees. Mr. Cavanagh said they would have to ask the Western Reserve Land Conservancy. Mr. McCune Jr. stated the Township cannot cut anything, unless they go through the land conservancy. Mr. McCune said the next time they do their walk with the Western Reserve Land Conservancy, he would ask.

ADJOURNMENT:




