The regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Trustee Chairman Eugene T. McCune Jr. Also in attendance was Trustee Patrick J. Cavanagh. Trustee Michael S. Troyan was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Geauga County Auditor, Charles E. Walder.

### **GUESTS:**

Gauga County Auditor, Charles E. Walder, and the County Compliance Officer Kate Jacob were in attendance to report on the progress of refunding Auburn Township taxpayers the monies erroneously collected from a prior township Road & Bridge levy. Kate reported the firm, American Legal Claim Services LLC has successfully refunded 80.95% of the \$752,041.72 or 2600 of the 3212 checks sent Auburn Township property owners. The remaining 19.05% or 612 checks currently remain outstanding or were returned undeliverable. The checks are valid for 90 days ending July 23, 2025. Efforts will be made beyond this date to contact property owners before any money is placed into the State of Ohio, Unclaimed Funds. Auburn trustees offered to assist with the effort if they are made aware of those property owners whose checks remain outstanding.

Chuck Walder also reported that Geauga County is taking steps to secure our public Wi-Fi networks due to a multi-county phishing attack. Various counties in Ohio have been cyber-attacked and sensitive data stolen. The Geauga County ADP Cyber Security Division is requiring all employees not to use public Wi-Fi networks to log into their government accounts.

### **MINUTE APPROVAL:**

**Motion by Patrick J Cavanagh, seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees held on June 2, 2025. VOTE: Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.**

### **SCHEDULED REPORTS:**

Auburn Fire Department, 2<sup>nd</sup> Assistant Chief Doug Artman, presented the monthly detailed report for the Auburn Fire Department. He presented a Year-to-Date Statistics Report comparing 418 year-to-date (Jan–May) total calls in 2025 to 387 year-to-date (Jan–May) total calls in 2024. The percentage of multiple calls was 26.32% for Jan-May 2025 compared to 21.70% in Jan–May 2024.

Mr. Artman also reported that the fire department annual clam bake will be held on Saturday September 27, 2025.

### **TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS:**

**Mr. Patrick J Cavanagh** reported that the Large Item Trash Day held on June 7<sup>th</sup> was a success. Fiscal Officer Dan Matsko reported that \$606 was collected this year compared to \$385 last year. A total of 116 residents with either a small vehicle load or larger truck/trailer load participated this year. Seniors, 60 yrs of age or older and residents with tires only were not charged a fee representing 68 of the 116 participants.

**Fiscal Officer Dan Matsko** presented the payment listing for payments processed since June 2, 2025 - listing 18 electronic payments processed for \$38,985.120 and 20 warrants processed for \$119,455.99 totaling \$158,441.11.

Mr. Matsko also reported receiving a new laptop and printer provided by the Ohio Auditor of State for utilizing their Uniform Accounting Network (UAN) software. The State of Ohio does not want the 4-year-old laptop and printer returned. It is common practice for the Board of Trustees to accept the old laptop and printer as township property and utilize or dispose of according to township policy. There currently is no need for either item by any of the township departments.

**Motion made by Eugene T. McCune Jr. and seconded by Patrick J Cavanagh to accept the 4-year-old printer and laptop valued less than \$2,500 as township property and dispose of them according to the Unused Equipment policy established at the annual Organizational Meeting in January. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes Cavanagh, yes. The motion PASSED.**

Mr. Matsko reported that Phase III of the Engineering Proposal-Onsite Sewage Treatment System is complete, and invoice paid to Buckley Group, LLC formally Hess & Associates Engineering. Phase IV of the intended project remains to be completed for a final fee of \$5,200.

Mr. Matsko stated that Cable Communications installed the cell booster equipment to allow cell phone reception inside the service garage building. Road Superintendent Mike Fenstermaker told Mr. Matsko that the system is working as intended. That invoice was also paid today.

**Eugene T. McCune Jr.** stated that Kathy McGrath was looking into putting some items together for an Auburn/Bainbridge Museum at one of the schools. He asked Mr. Cavanagh if he wouldn't mind looking into it. Mr. Cavanagh said he would contact her.

## OLD BUSINESS:

No old business.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. McCune Jr. presented Resolution 2025-09 Certificate of Need for the renewal of an existing 1.00 mill Road & Bridge levy last voted on in 2020. The levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on November 4, 2025, and shall first be levied in tax year 2026 and begin collection in 2027. Mr. Cavanagh stated the levy is placed on the ballot a year early to prevent two levies being placed on the ballot at the same time in the future. He also stated the prosecutor's office has assisted in drafting the language of the resolution.

**Motion made by Patrick J Cavanagh and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to adopt Resolution 2025-09 Certificate of Need for the 1.00 mill renewal levy. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes Cavanagh, yes. The motion PASSED.**

Mr. McCune Jr. presented the Auburn Township Tuition Loan Agreement with road department employee Nathan Munn to fund the attendance of an instruction program for obtaining a Class B commercial driver's license. The agreement states Auburn Township will pay for class tuition up to \$2,600, lodging up to \$800, meals and incidental expenses up to \$350 and mileage expense at \$0.70 per mile. The agreement also states that Nathan Munn agrees to repay the total sum paid by the township if the program is not successfully completed and passed including receipt of Class B CDL by December 31, 2025. In addition, employee Nathan Munn agrees to remain employed with Auburn Township for two years from the date the course is completed.

**Motion made by Patrick J Cavanagh and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr. to enter into the Tuition Loan Agreement with Nathan Munn to attend and complete the necessary instruction for obtaining a Class B CDL and payment of tuition, lodging, meals and incidental expenses up to \$3,750 and mileage expense at \$0.70 per mile. VOTE: McCune Jr., yes Cavanagh, yes. The motion PASSED.**

Mr. McCune Jr. brought up for discussion the request by the service department for working seasonal hours, 4 ten-hour days Monday through Thursday beginning the first Monday following the first Saturday in June and ending sometime in October. Mr. Cavanagh stated Mantua and Newbury operate their road departments with seasonal hours. Mr. McCune expressed concerns with no one from the road department being here on a Friday to take calls from township residents. Other concerns involved weather-related incidents, funerals and payment of overtime wages if they had to be called in on a Friday. It was decided to table any further discussion until all members of the board are present and each trustee has more time to ponder the request.
