The regular meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Trustee Chairman Eugene T. McCune Jr. Also in attendance were Trustees Michael S. Troyan and Patrick J. Cavanagh.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Will Szarka.

## **MINUTE APPROVAL:**

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr., to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Auburn Township Board of Trustees held on June 16, 2025. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

### **SCHEDULED REPORTS:**

Mr. Frank Kitko, Zoning Inspector, submitted a Zoning report reflecting 7 different applications submitted in the month of June 2025.

The Trustees reviewed the preliminary plan for Klarich Farms Subdivision, lots 7 & 17, Section 6, Tract 1, provided by the Geauga County Planning Commission.

There was no report from the Road Department.

Mr. Cavanagh stated he attended a pre-construction meeting last week, for the upcoming road project.

Mr. Cavanagh said there will be a Stafford Road closure, probably around September 2025. The state will be replacing some 100-year-old pipe under the road. Mr. Cavanagh and Mr. Fenstermaker are working on getting a notification out to at least the Stafford Road residents, as well as getting signage together. Mr. Cavanagh explained that this work should have been going on already, but all the bids for this project came in over budget – so the project had to be redesigned and rebid.

#### TRUSTEE & FISCAL OFFICER REPORTS:

Mr. Michael S. Troyan thanked the Boy Scouts, and everyone involved with the Fourth of July parade and activities. Mr. Troyan noted the parade was well organized, and they had a good turnout. He also thanked the Road Department for all their work in getting everything set up.

Mr. Troyan addressed the Certificate of Need, Resolution Number 2025-09, which was addressed at the last Trustees Meeting. The date on the first page of that Resolution was incorrect.

Motion made by Michael S. Troyan to rescind Resolution 2025-09 and seconded by Patrick J. Cavanagh. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Mr. Troyan read the new Resolution 2025-10, for a Certificate of Need, in which Auburn Township found it necessary to levy a tax – ORC 5705 19(G) for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in Auburn Township. The levy is to be placed on the ballot at the election held on November 4, 2025, and shall first be levied in the year 2026 and will begin collection in 2027.

A Motion was made by Michael S. Troyan and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr., to approve Resolution 2025-10. Mr. Cavanagh stated this was a renewal levy. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Patrick J. Cavanagh had nothing additional to report.

**Eugene T. McCune Jr.** reported that he, Mr. Fenstermaker and Ms. Dolezal met last week with the representative from OTARMA, which is a governmental risk-sharing pool whose members consist solely of Ohio Townships and provides Townships with insurance coverages – including comprehensive liability and property coverages.

Mr. McCune Jr. noted that they meet with OTARMA every couple of years, and OTARMA gives Auburn Township a list of items that can be improved, to limit liability. OTARMA gave the Trustees 13 suggestions for areas that could be improved. Some of the items included were an annual sexual harassment/anti-harassment training, updated written job descriptions, a liquor liability policy when alcohol is served.

Mr. McCune Jr. thought the Trustees should look at the items OTARMA recommended be implemented, and felt most of them could be accomplished.

Mr. McCune Jr. congratulated Fire Chief John Phillips on his 51 years of service working for the Fire Department. Mr. McCune Jr. also thanked the Boy Scouts and Matt England - who was the organizer of the parade; he did a great job and noted the parade was enjoyed by a lot of people.

**Fiscal Office report - Mr. Dan Matsko, Fiscal Officer,** presented the payment listing for payments processed since June 16, 2025 - listing 16 electronic payments processed for \$62,137.45, and 25 warrants processed for \$37,302.39, totaling \$99,439.84. Mr. Matsko said he completed the June 2025 bank reconciliation, and as of June 30, 2025, they had \$612,141.99 in the primary checking account. In the Star Ohio account, they had \$2,231,437.16 for a total of \$2,843,579.15.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

Mr. McCune Jr. discussed seasonal hours for the service department. It was brought up that the Road department would be interested in working a four-day work week, with extended hours, versus the current schedule. Mr. McCune Jr. had concerns about the service department not being properly staffed to service the residents 5 days per week, as the Township is in a service business, and here to help the residents of Auburn Township. Mr. Troyan said he would need to see a lot more details and how this would benefit the Township. Mr. Troyan and Mr. Cavanagh felt even if details were figured out, it was probably too late to look at for this year.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Motion made by Eugene T. McCune Jr. and seconded by Michael S. Troyan to approve the address for parcel number 01-118986, as 10115 Gottschalk Pkwy, as recommended by the Geauga County Engineer. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion PASSED.

Motion by Michael S. Troyan and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr., to approve a 3-year service agreement with KINETIC BUSINESS / WINDSTREAM (for 7 Auburn Township properties) at \$830.76/month (\$138.97 less than the last service agreement three years ago.) VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion passed.

Motion by Patrick J. Cavanagh and seconded by Eugene T. McCune Jr., to approve a quote from Judco Truck Equipment for a 2025 Valley Freightliner Build-Out at \$117, 270.00. Mr. Cavanagh noted the specifications for this truck were carefully done by Michael Ludwig of the Service department. VOTE: Troyan, yes; Cavanagh, yes; McCune Jr., yes. The motion passed.
