Mr. Van Hyning commented that the next meeting will be the public hearing, for the amendments, on August 14, 2025.

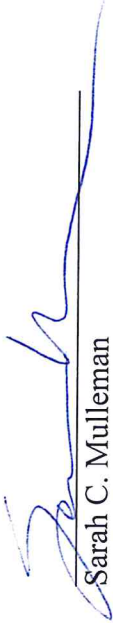
