Mr. Troyan wanted Ms. Dolezal to put together information she had on what she did for Memorial Day, trash pickup and large item trash pickup, etc.




The Trustees discussed keeping the previous scheduled special meeting open – April 29, 2026, for the possibility of discussion/hiring of the administrative assistant.

ADJOURNMENT:


