Members briefly discussed recent State of Ohio discussions regarding the potential increase in marijuana dispensaries based on the number of registered medical marijuana patients. The Commission noted that the matter was not currently relevant to Auburn Township and no action was taken.

The Commission continued the review and revision of the proposed Auto Services amendment.

The Commission reviewed terminology throughout the amendment to ensure consistency. Members agreed to remove the term "retail" from the Auto Repair Garage definition to clarify that gas pumps remain prohibited, remove the term "retail" from the Auto Service Station definition to maintain consistency in the amendment language, and remove references to "retail sale" where appropriate throughout the amendment.

Following discussion and revisions, the Commission proceeded with initiating Amendment ZC-2026-01.
